REMINDER NOTICE

Dear Owner,

This is a reminder notice that last week there was a phishing attempt made from an inactive email from owner@liftlodgeresort.com. The phishing attempt disguised itself as an email requesting users to download an attachment and enter in a password of "777". Many users who received this phishing attempt email may have thought it had something to do with the upcoming Maintenance Fee Billing statements that are due to mail out very soon.

If you may have clicked on the phishing attempt attachment sent by owner@liftlodgeresort.com, please change your email password immediately. We advise that you also delete the email from your inbox as well. Phishing attempts like these are targeted to harvest emails and send out more "fake emails" to get as many contacts as possible.

We also advise that you remove owner@liftlodgeresort.com from your email address book and contacts.
